The preanesthetic charts were reviewed and the information about the age, surgical risk, ASA classification, the cardiological history and medication, the physical examination findings, and the tests ordered was recorded. B-blockers and statins were correctly continued to all the patients who were taking them. 1055 patients were receiving ACEIs or ARBs for hypertension and should have discontinued their medication, but none did. 53,4% (31) of the patients with known systolic heart failure were not being treated with ACEIs or ARBs as they should and were operated despite the recommendation to begin treatment for at least 1 week before surgery. The overall percentage of the patients managed exactly as recommended was only 27,3%.
